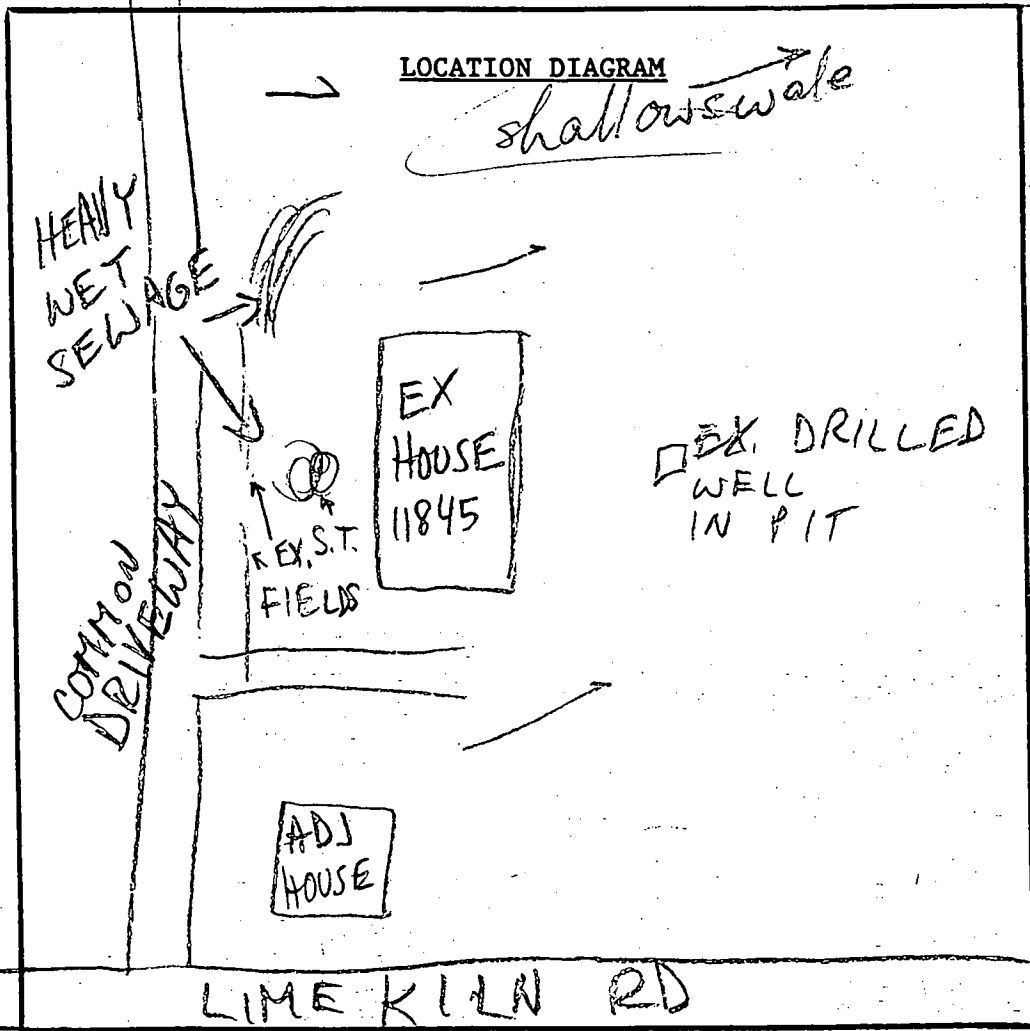

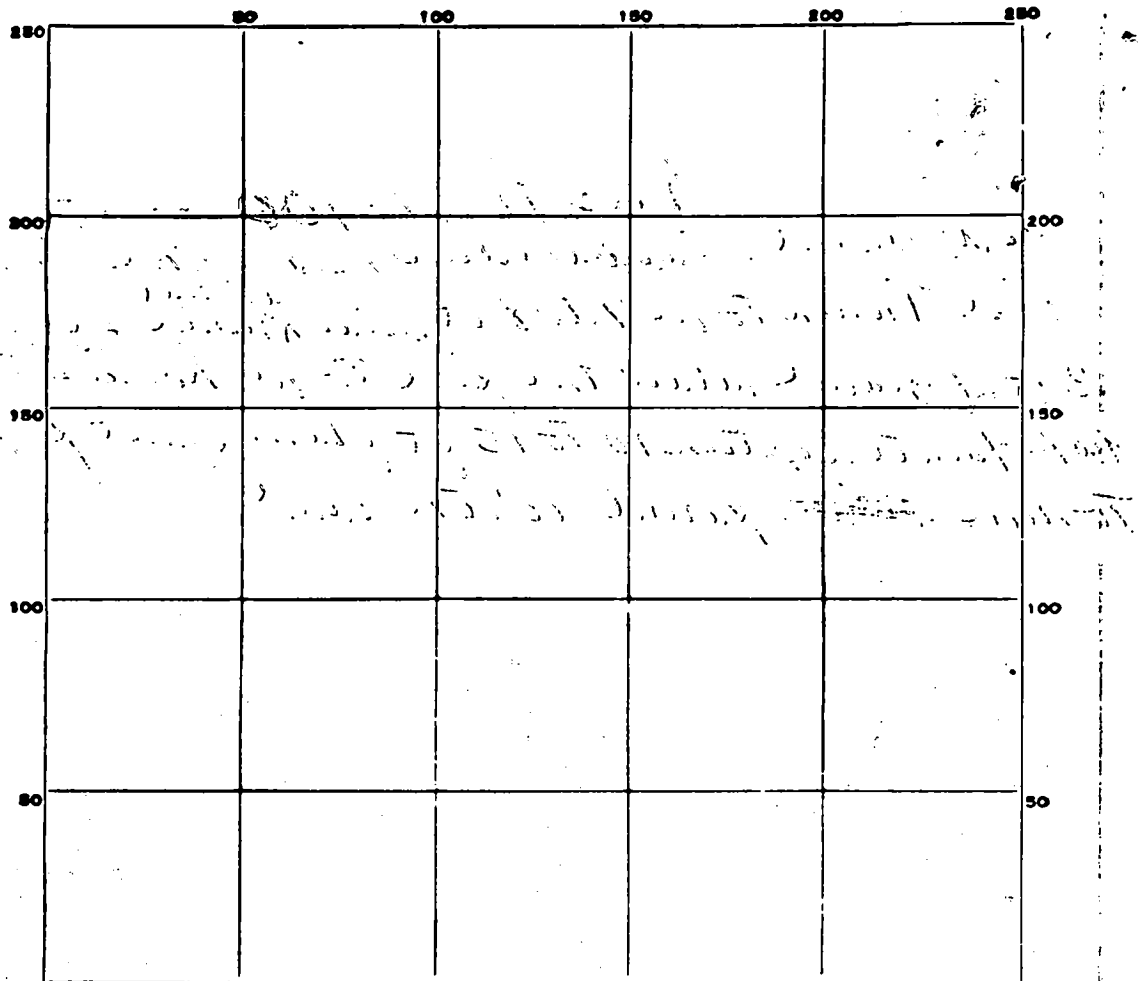

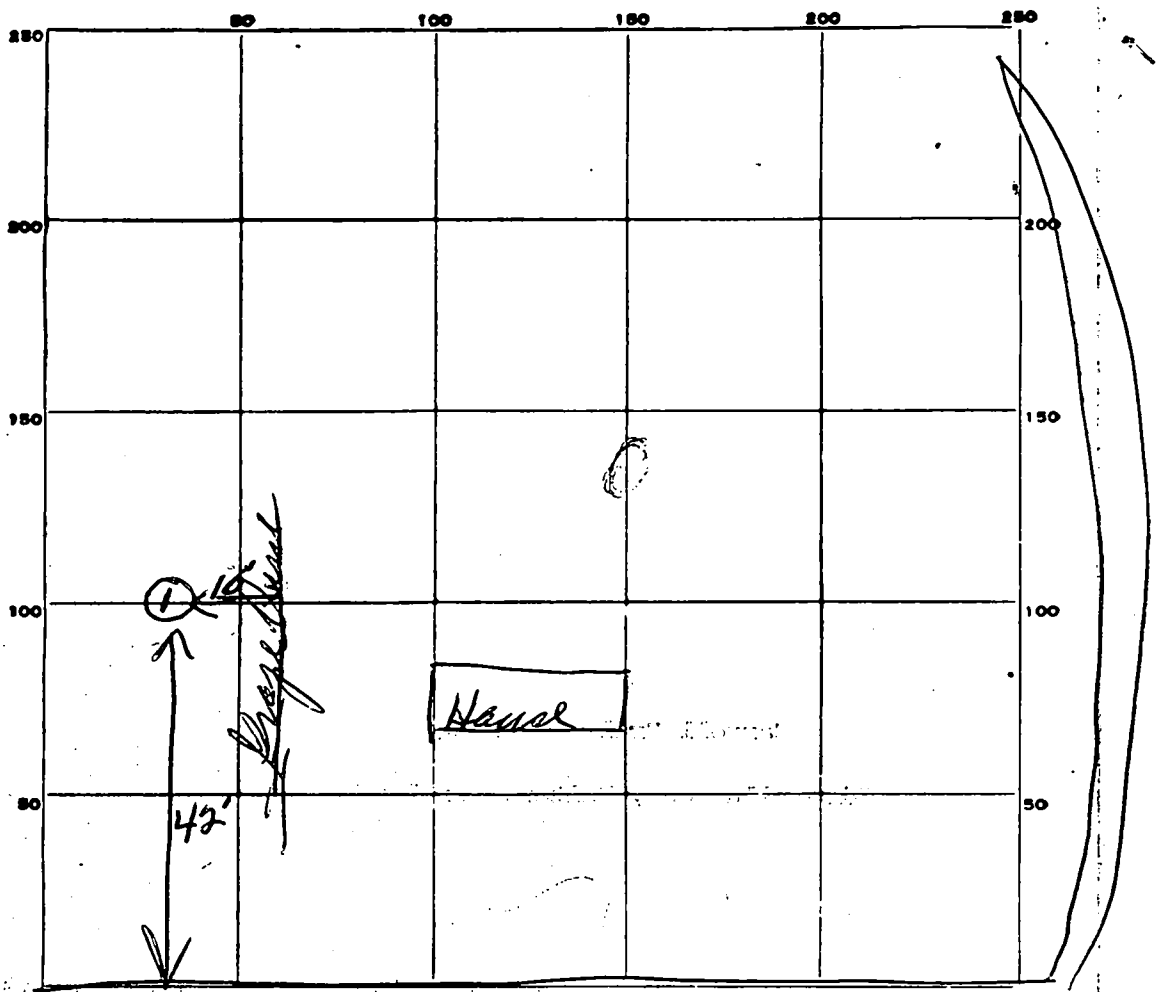

Dear Mr. Atwell:

The above-referenced Notice of Violation is hereby terminated. The condition cited in the Notice, which was issued on April 24, 1995 pursuant to Howard County Code Section 12.110, has been remediated. Confirmation of said remediation is described below.

On December 23, 1996, Ron Pinkley, a sanitarian from this office, conducted a septic system repair inspection at your property located at the above referenced address. On that date, Mr. Pinkley observed the installation of a new septic system trench (drainfield) approximately fifty feet uphill of the existing house. The septic system repair was approved by Mr. Pinkley that same day. The discharge previously observed has been eliminated.

The existing septic tank is believed to be potentially vulnerable to water table seepage, which could overload the drainfield and cause another system failure. However, Mr. Pinkley approved your request to keep the tank in service due to the limited financial resources available. It is strongly recommended that this tank be replaced with a water-tight (top-seamed) septic tank as soon as possible.

Due to the high water table, the small lot size and other considerations, suitable area for additional repairs may be difficult to obtain. For this reason, household water usage should be limited to only what is absolutely necessary. As with any new septic system, the new drainfield has a limited life expectancy, but the specific length of time cannot be determined.

Additionally, as with any property, any new sewage discharges will be cause for additional enforcement actions.

This office had agreed to postpone the deadline for your septic system repair contingent upon the septic tank being pumped as necessary to prevent additional sewage overflows.

On October 13, 1995, I conducted a re-inspection of your property to verify that additional discharges were not being produced. On that occasion I observed sewage discharges in the same locations as previously noted, indicating that the septic tank was not being pumped with sufficient frequency.

Until repairs to the septic system are complete, you must immediately have the septic tank contents pumped by a licensed sewage scavenger, and you are reminded that pumping must continue as often as necessary to prevent future sewage overflows.

If these conditions are not met, we will proceed with further enforcement actions. If you have any questions relative to this matter, please contact me at 313-2640.

Dear Mr. Atwell:

This is to confirm the content of my phone message to you on September 26, 1996.

On April 24, 1995, this office issued a Notice of Violation which required repair of the septic system and maintenance septic tank pumping at the above referenced property. Since June, 1995, you have repeatedly advised me of the imminent availability of funds to complete the required repairs. To date, repairs have not been initiated to abate this nuisance, and maintenance pumping of the septic tank has not occurred with sufficient frequency to prevent additional discharges.

Due to the excessive delay in completing the septic system repair, this office is prepared to request that the Howard County Office of Law file a complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief, asking that the District Court issue an order requiring the immediate repair of the system. Litigation, however, is not the County's preferred method of solving problems. The Health Department will allow you one final opportunity to resolve this issue informally and to address the situation without court action.

I strongly suggest that you advise me of a timetable for completion within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter. Otherwise, this office will request the Office of Law to proceed with initiation of court action.

Please call me at 313-2640 to advise me as to the status of this matter.

Dear Mr. Atwell:

On March 11, 1995, Mr. Mark Rifkin, Sanitarian from this office inspected your property known as Tax Map 46, Parcel 201, located at 11845 Lime Kiln Road in response to a report of an overflowing septic system. On that occasion, Mr. Rifkin observed two locations of heavy sewage discharge in the front yard.

This condition is in violation of Section 12.110 of the Howard County Code.

As the failing septic system creates a condition which is, or may be hazardous to the public health, you are hereby ordered to apply to this office for a septic system repair permit and effect repairs within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this letter. The cost of the septic repair permit is \$25.00. Until repairs are completed you must immediately (within 48 hours) have the septic tank and drywell contents pumped by a licensed sewage scavenger; and continue pumping, as often as necessary to prevent future sewage overflows.

Based on your report of financial difficulties, enclosed is an application packet for financial assistance offered by the Howard County Office of Housing and Community Development.


If you believe that the condition described above is not and could not be a hazard to health, or that the Health Department is not acting in compliance with pertinent laws and regulations, you may request a formal hearing before the Board of Health within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter. If you wish to discuss the evidence, the regulations, or your individual circumstances, you are encouraged to request a meeting with us by calling 313-2640 and scheduling an appointment.
