In response to the request of Anne Shank of your office, this is to confirm that the above referenced property failed the standard percolation test on several occasions.

Unsuccessful tests were conducted on the following dates: August 18, 1966, March 27, 1985, April 29, 1986. Attempts by the applicant to establish that the property qualified under standards for innovative and alternative septic systems were also unsuccessful.

The property is considered by the Howard County Health Department to be "non-buildable" under the standards of current Individual Water and Sewage Disposal Regulations (COMAR 26.04.02).
