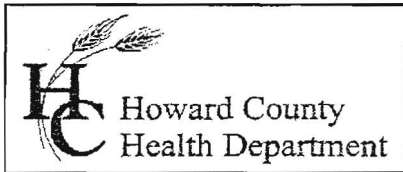



This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

According to public utility records, this parcel is currently connected to public water and will remain so. The water contract 647-w install date has been verified. The as built date is July, 1981.

The existing septic system on this property may be abandoned during demolition of the structure. **Confirmation of this task with proper documentation must be submitted and received by this office once completed.**

If plans to re-build on this parcel, you will need to re-connect to public water and sewer per Howard County code.

If any wells or septic systems are found during site work, you must notify this office immediately.
