The resulting private sewage easement is at least 10,000 square feet as required by the Maryland Department of Environment for individual sewage disposal. Improvements of any nature in this area are restricted. This easement shall become null and void upon connection to a public sewerage system. The county health officer shall have the authority to grant adjustments to the private sewage easement. Recordation of a revised sewage easement shall not be necessary.

Existing 1250 gallon septic tank to be replaced with a new 2000 gallon tank. All other existing structures, wells, septic systems, and sewage easements to remain.
