(Demolition of existing house – rebuild new dwelling)

This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

According to utility records, this parcel currently resides in the metropolitan district area for public water access. The existing well (located under the steps of the house) was sealed by Charles Youngbar of Allied Well Drilling (MD License MWD 326). Plans to rebuild, you will need to connect to public water per Howard County code.

The existing septic system may be sealed during demolition. Please verify this task has been properly completed by submitting documentation to the Health Department once abandonment has been completed (i.e. date of abandonment, who performed the abandonment, how it was abandoned, filled in with clean fill, stone etc...)

If plans to rebuild a new house, you must connect to private water. Public sewer is not available. A Percolation Certification plan establishing an initial and future septic reserve area has been developed and approved for this property.

If any other wells or septic systems are encountered during site work, you must notify this office immediately!
