This is to advise you that the septic system was installed, inspected and approved on June 15, 1990.

The water sample recently submitted for testing was free of coliform and fecal coliform bacteria at the time of sampling and is bacteriologically safe for drinking.

INTERIM CERTIFICATE OF POTABILITY

This certifies that the initial sampling requirements of COMAR 26.04.04 "Well Regulations" have been met for the water supply system installed under permit(s) HO-81-0792. No guarantee can be given for health protection beyond this date of issue. Based upon a satisfactory investigation and evaluation by the Howard County Health Department, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene accepts this well system as required by COMAR 26.04.04.09.
