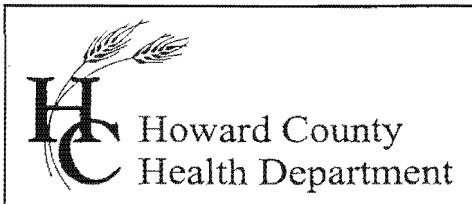

The Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the requested demolition permit for the referenced property. Because there aren't any relevant records for this property Mike Collins has agreed to do the following during the demolition process.

The abandoned well on the property will be inspected to ensure that it has been sealed correctly. If the well hasn't been sealed correctly, then if at all possible, steps will be taken to ensure that it is sealed correctly. A licensed well driller should seal the well.

If an improperly abandoned septic system is located during the demolition process, then any components such as a tank or drywell that could pose a future hazard will be pumped out and filled with dirt.

Please supply the Health Department with any documentation or proof of work done involving the above.
