This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

The existing pit well that once served the referenced property was properly located. It appears that the existing pit/hand-dug well that once served the property was sealed during time public water install. No record of this abandonment on file.

The existing septic system that once served the property was properly located, pumped and collapsed by JA Construction. Documentation, invoices, and pictures were received that this task was properly completed.

Current utility records show this parcel has access to public water and sewer. If plans to rebuild, you will need to connect to public utilities per Howard County Code.
