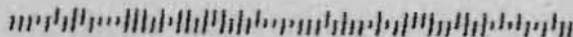

A field review was conducted in relation to a complaint regarding sewage discharging to the ground at 12020 Old Frederick Road, Marriottsville, MD 21104 (Tax Map 10, Grid 19, Parcel 19). The Health Department observed sewage on the ground surface that had discharged from a pipe extending from the basement of the house. The source of the discharge appears to be a grinder pit connected to indoor plumbing.

The observed sewage condition is in violation of the *Code of Maryland Regulations* (COMAR) 26.04.02.02(D): "A person may not dispose of sewage, body, or industrial wastes in any manner which may cause pollution of the ground surface, the waters of the State, or create a nuisance." This condition is also in violation of the *Howard County Code* 3.804(a)(1), as a sewage overflow is defined as a nuisance, {12.110(a)}. The Health Department is issuing a Notice of Violation for the above offenses.

The sewage in the yard is considered a public health nuisance and requires cleanup. The following steps must be taken immediately:

1. Cease use of the plumbing fixtures that are contributing to the waste disposing onto the ground. The pump discharging sewage to the ground must also be disconnected to prevent further discharge.
2. Contact a sewage hauler to pump out existing waste in the grinder pump and on the ground. Documentation must be submitted to our office once this task is completed.
3. Spread hydrated lime over the contaminated soil in order to prevent the spread of contamination.

In addition, you are required to contact the Health Department with seven (7) days to discuss permanent abatement of the plumbing contributing to waste discharging onto the ground. Any work under permits issued by the Health Department must be completed within thirty (30) days.

Failure to complete any of the requirements listed above will result in a citation. Under *Howard County Code 3.821(c)(5)(ii)(c)*, each day this violation is allowed to occur is considered a separate offense.

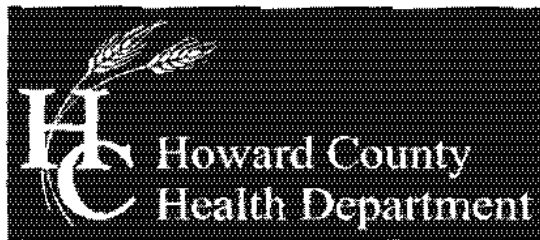

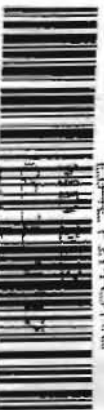
