Demolition of old house on property; new house built

This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

The old house was served by a hand dug well. The well was sealed by Fogle's Well Drilling on 1/3/18 and the Health Department received documentation.

The old house had a septic tank that led to a drainfield. Earl E. Preston Jr., Inc. pumped and filled in the tank with clean dirt on 1/5/18. The Health Department witnessed the tank abandonment.

Current utility records show this parcel has no access to public utilities. Future development may require percolation testing and the development of a Percolation Certification Plan per *Howard County Code section 3.805*.

IF ANY ADDITIONAL WELL OR SEPTIC COMPONENTS ARE FOUND DURING SITE WORK, PLEASE NOTIFY THE HOWARD COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY.
