
The following is a point-by-point response regarding your letter dated November 5, 2008.

I have received a comprehensive review of the process from the Howard County Health Department staff. They tell me that as of their letter to you of 11/5/08, 2 tasks remained. At my request they supplied a copy of all correspondence pertaining to this process. The tasks were 1. The field survey (which you did not perform) and 2. General notes to be revised to indicate the new well locations.

I have received some bills here for several hundred dollars and yet the Health Department tells me they have yet to receive the change in the general notes relating to the wells (point 2 above). Please see that it is taken care of and also keep this project (file) on inactive reserve so we can complete the certification at a later date.

This is also an opportune time for you to send me the report conclusions relating to your examination of the development of my 3 parcels which were determined to be accomplished appropriately by boundary transfers of adjoining properties. Jack Cooper tells me that this report should appropriately come from your engineering firm. Once again supporting documents should be kept on record by your firm or else sent to me.
