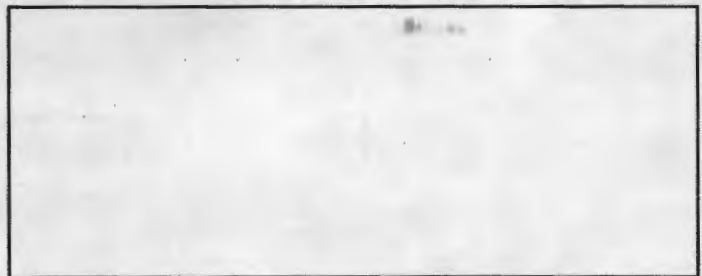

Hi Katie,

Thanks for meeting with me at Daniels Road yesterday.

I spoke with my supervisor regarding the well and the Health Department cannot sign off on the abandonment at this time. The Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 26.04.04.34G states that a well must be sealed either by a licensed well driller in the state of Maryland or under the supervision of the Approving Authority (Health Department). I have been in contact with John Boris at MDE and he stated that the Health Department must follow the regulations laid out in COMAR.

We will approve the abandonment if we receive an abandonment report filled out by a licensed well driller. Please contact a well driller to determine how they would recommend you proceed. I have attached a list of well drillers active in Howard County.

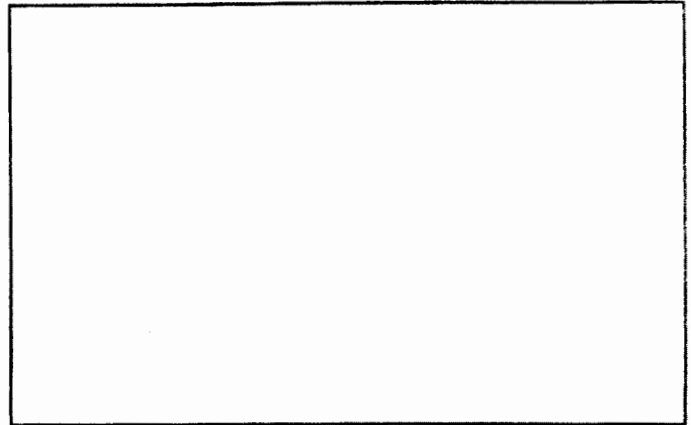



Hello,

I work with the Howard County Health Department in the Well & Septic Program and we recently learned of a hand dug well that was not property sealed during a demolition of a ranger house in the Daniels Area of Patapsco State Park. Dirt Express completed the demolition and Abend Plumbing sealed the well. The Code of Maryland Regulations states that a well must be sealed either by a licensed well driller in the state of Maryland or under the supervision of the Approving Authority (Health Department). Abend Plumbing does not have a licensed well driller at the company and a well that was not property sealed can pose a potential danger.

The Health Department typically reviews permits for demolition to ensure that all well & septic components are properly abandoned. The Health Department never reviewed a demolition request for this property, listed as 2210 Daniels Road in our records. Was it listed under another address?

I visited the site of the former house yesterday at Daniels Area and there appears to be another smaller structure partway down the hill. I saw terracotta pipes leading to a stream, which could be an old septic system. I'd like to determine if the structure was served by a well- does the State have records of this property?



Hi Debbie,

The Health Department recently learned of a demolition at Patapsco Daniels Area ranger house with the address 2210 Daniels Road. The demolition occurred in the fall of 2018 and no demolition request ever came through our office. Does DILP have anything on file for this address?

The house was razed and Abend Plumbing abandoned the hand dug well on site. All wells must be sealed by a licensed well driller and Abend does not have a driller at their company. An improperly sealed well can be a potential danger.

I visited the site yesterday and noticed another smaller structure partway down the hill from the razed house. The building has terracotta pipes leading to the stream, a potential old septic system. I'm concerned that there could be a well serving this structure as well.

Please let me know if DILP has any information regarding this demolition.
