This office has received the above referenced building permit application to add a two-story addition to the existing house.

As no record of the septic system for this property exists, and you are proposing an increase in the maximum occupancy of the home, you are required to expand or repair your septic system.

Since Mr. Stayer's visit to your property on October 26, 1983, I have located percolation test results for a proposed septic system repair on your property. These tests were apparently done by Roland Barth on September 26, 1973 but no repair was ever made.

A ten dollar (\$10.00) fee for the septic system repair permit is required.

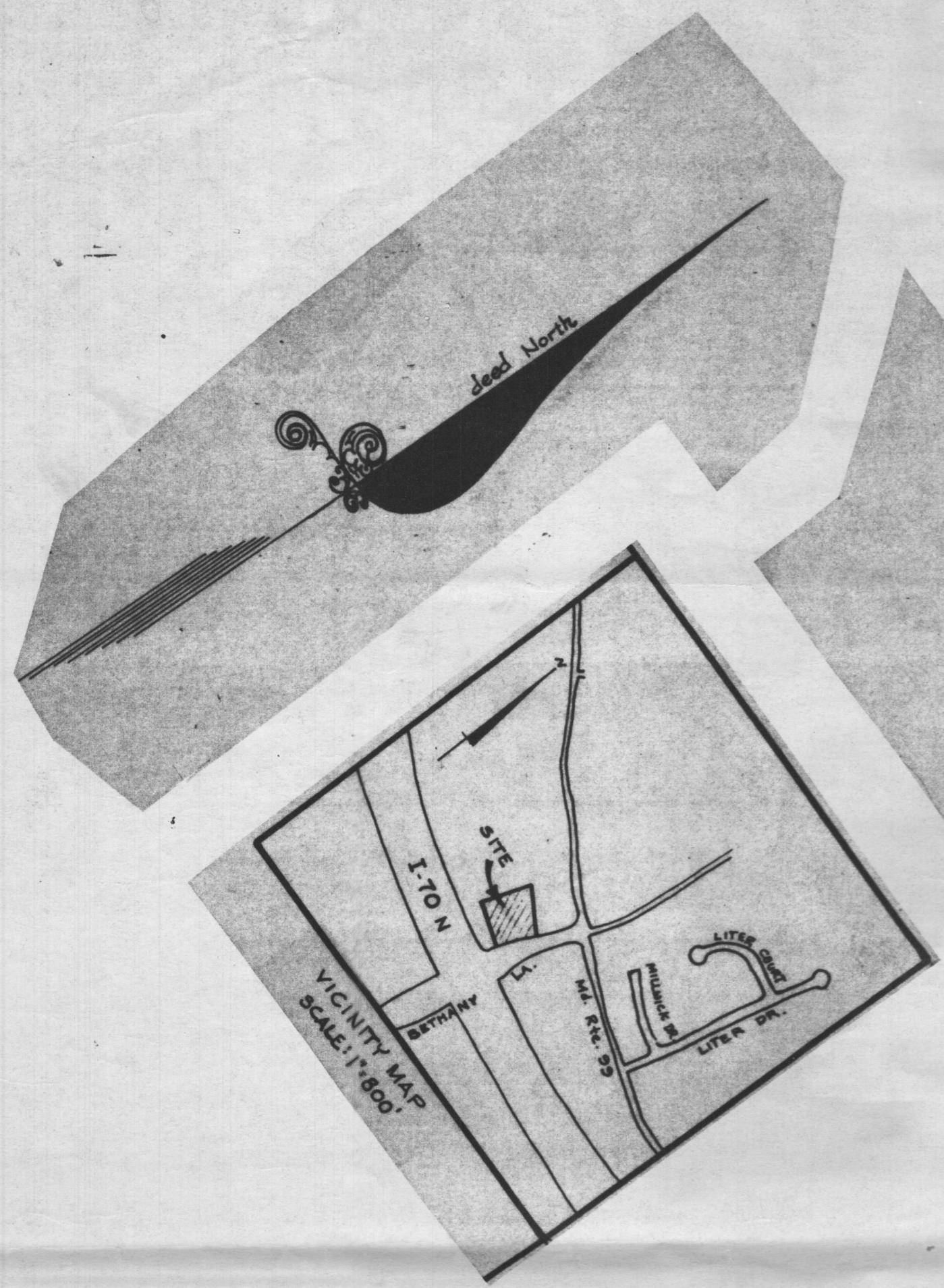

SCALE: 1" = 20' DATE: 8-1-77

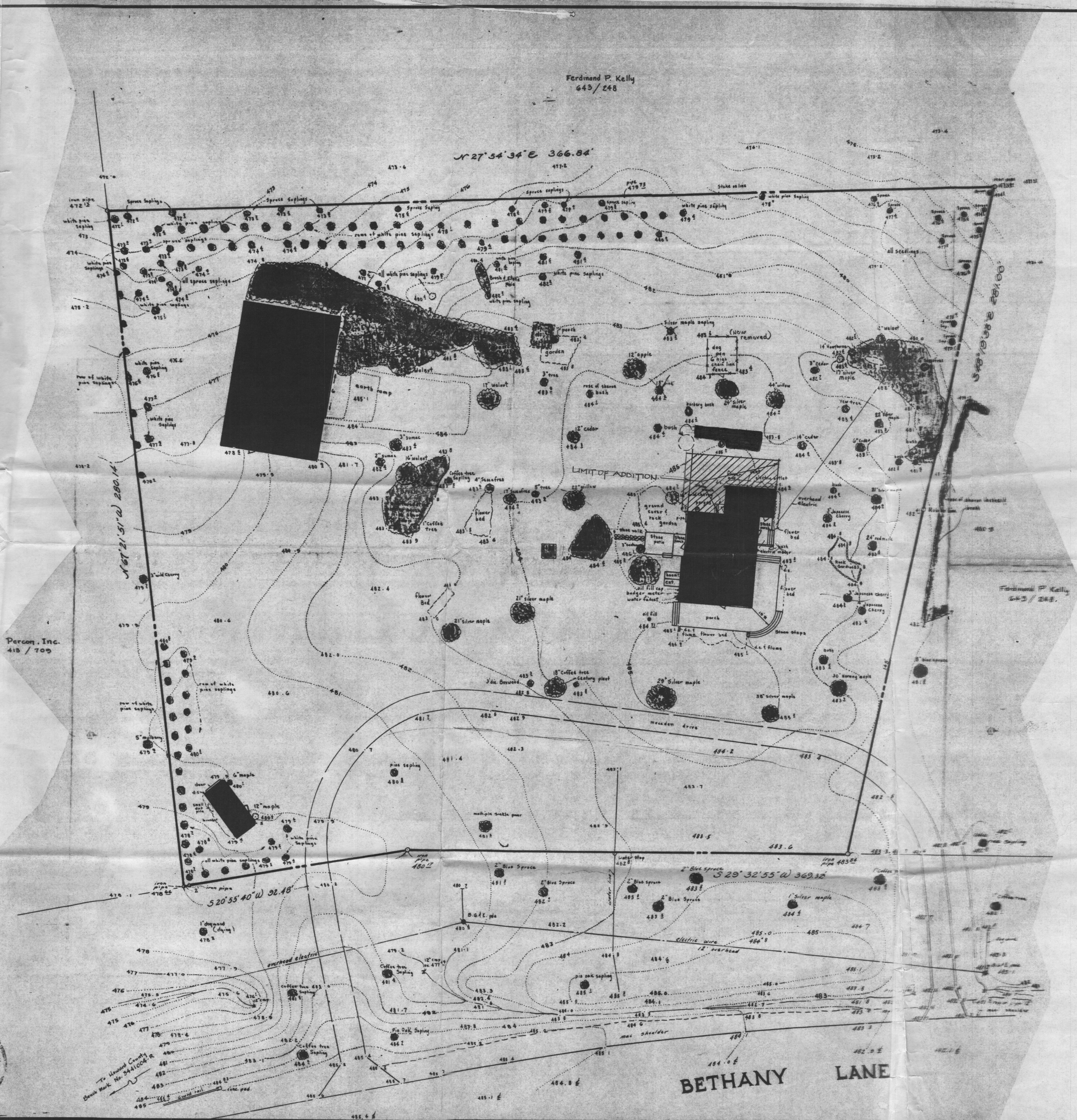
