This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

Since this dwelling is reported to be built in 1910 it is highly likely that there are both well and onsite septic components on this property. There are currently no public records at the Health Department identifying locations for either a well or an onsite septic system. The Health Department was not able to conduct a proper inspection of the property to search for these components due to vegetation overgrowth and an unsafe structure.

It is requested that a Health Department representative be onsite once the vegetation has been cleared so a proper search for well and septic components can be conducted. Please email both kwolf@howardcountymd.gov and rrappaport@howardcountymd.gov when you feel that the property is safe for inspection access. If for some reason an existing well is located on the property by your demolition contractor it must be properly sealed and abandoned according to State regulations, COMAR 26.04.04.34, by a Maryland Licensed Well Driller. A Water Well Abandonment Sealing Report Form must be submitted to this office to be added to the Health Department file for this property. If any other wells are located during the demolition process, they must also be sealed and abandoned according to the same State regulations. If any septic components are located during the demolition process they must also be properly abandoned according to Howard County Code Subtitle 8, Section 3.810(g) by an approved septic system contractor or licensed plumber.

According to utility records, this property has access to public water and sewer. If you plan to re-build on this parcel, you will need to connect to public water and sewer per Howard County specifications and regulations if water and sewer are required for the new construction.

My experience on these aged properties almost always leads to old hand-dug wells and cesspools that are not easily seen from the surface. In fact, the wells can originate under the house foundation which makes it even harder to find. If there any low lying areas or streams nearby on the property, you may also encounter open pipes to daylight as this was the norm in that time frame. Let me know if you need anything further.

I've already set up with Envir Services to have a well driller on call to do an abandonment if required (in other words if we can find what to abandon.) HTI will start at the clean out and find what we find and do what you ask.

The problem will come with the basement. Access is not safe and there's about 2 to 3 feet of sediment in the basement. Absolutely no way I can see to determine safely what's underneath since the whole structure could come crashing down.

Can we meet at the site or can you have someone do a site visit to confirm these conditions and we can develop an acceptable approach together?

Kris:

I added a few comments to your application but can't yet approve.

In cases like this, we know they have some sort of system, as they were never connected. We usually let people proceed with the stipulation to call only when it's an old house connected to public and we don't know if there's an old system somewhere.

Is the county doing the demo here? If you are not, then I would suggest you have the hired contractor do some digging "up front" (in the area of the cleanout and prior to starting demolition) to see what they have and pump out what they find. After pumping to crush and fill in, this clears this part of the demo. At a minimum, we will need to better understand what that cleanout is tied to.

With this age house, we usually need a search for a well, including getting us into the basement. Given all that is going on, perhaps sending us a video or something in the basement and search around themselves to see if one can be located. There has to be a well somewhere. We would have a driller seal it before demo so it doesn't get damaged and buried during demo.

Once we have some more clarity, we can expedite the demo approval.

I went out to the site today (the day I drafted this) as requested by BGE New Business in order to complete requirements for their "Raze Letter." That trip resulted in confirmation that the the property had/has overhead electric service. The service cable is still attached to the house, although the meter (both meters, actually. Gas and Electric) have been removed.

BGE created a job to remove the service cable with good weather date of 26 MAY 2020. Accordingly, we won't be starting your work on the 26th.

Your PO is now in place. Let's plan a start the last week of May. HCHD will also be onsite to ensure proper abandonment of any well or septic we find. If we find the well, we'll have to stop work and call in Niti's driller to abandon.

Hello Kris, Thanks for the reply. I'm happy to be available when HTI begins clearing the property. The inspectors in my office are mostly teleworking and I'm in the office once a week for inspections. If this is still how we're working after May 26, then you can reach out to me and I can come to the site from home if it's not on my regular office day (Thursday). My cell is 301-310-2248. I've had the opportunity to read through your communications with Bert and Kevin so I think you understand the importance of properly abandoning any well or septic components found on the property. The concern is that the well and septic may be buried once debris, dirt and construction materials start shifting around the property. We prefer that the well and septic abandonment work be completed before any major demo work on the structure begins. We do understand that in some cases it can't safely be done like that. So, if a HD representative is not onsite when you begin clearing the property, we request that the contractor contact us if/when any well or septic components are exposed and we can go from there. If there's any way that you can clear the vegetation before HTI begins work at the site, contact me and I can complete a thorough exploratory inspection. I saw mention of a Phase 1 Environmental Report being completed. This kind of report usually has information about any onsite well and/or septic components. If you get that report before May 26, please send it to me for review.

Hi Ryan,

We've reviewed the structure for safety and determined that entry is NOT SAFE.

As far as clearing, we'd like to get you on-site when HTI begins work. We can ask them to start with light clearing close to the perimeter (we want to minimize clearing until we determine the site's future/ultimate use) as they prepare to take down the structure. You can follow the clearing operation as it progresses around the perimeter.

Any and all possible advance work you can do before HTI mobilizes a crew and equipment to the site (for instance regarding septic poking around) would be greatly appreciated. Once HTI starts up, we want to keep them moving to the greatest possible extent. That said, we understand your needs for proper abandonment of well and septic if found.

BGE starts work (weather permitting) on 26 MAY to remove service cable. HTI will start as soon after they BGE finishes as schedules and weather allow. Can you be available on semi-short notice the last couple days of MAY?

Hopefully we can work these operations seamlessly together, rather than in a start-stop-start fashion. I guess that will depend on getting your formal clearance in advance of HTI's start, Engineering pulling the demo permit, then working together on demo day(s) to first investigate to HCHD's satisfaction and then take all HCHD required actions to make the site safe from your perspective. My previous discussions with Bert led to my understanding that this is the way we'd do it.

This way, the only hitch in steady progress we're looking at is IF we find the wellhead. In that case, we have to stop work, and wait for Niti to get her driller onsite to abandon.

We are committed to doing this right. Please confirm that HCHD agrees w this simultaneous approach.

Hi Kris, I had an opportunity to go take a look at the site yesterday and I didn't recognize it when I took a quick look at the map. But I surely recognized it when I got there. The HD has had a few complaints over the years regarding this property, it's kind of a disaster and we've never really made any headway. Yesterday, there was no safe way for me to properly explore and inspect the property to search for well and septic components. Since this structure was built in 1910 with no obvious renovations it's more likely that there's a well and a septic system somewhere. Would it be possible for Howard County to clear a reasonable amount of vegetation around the perimeter of the home at some point so I could come back for a closer look? Could you also take a look at the collapse of the embankment along Montgomery Road and the damage to the structure to see how safe it would be to inspect inside the home in case the well is under the home? I was hoping to get your thoughts and then we can most definitely continue to move forward. Have a nice weekend.
