

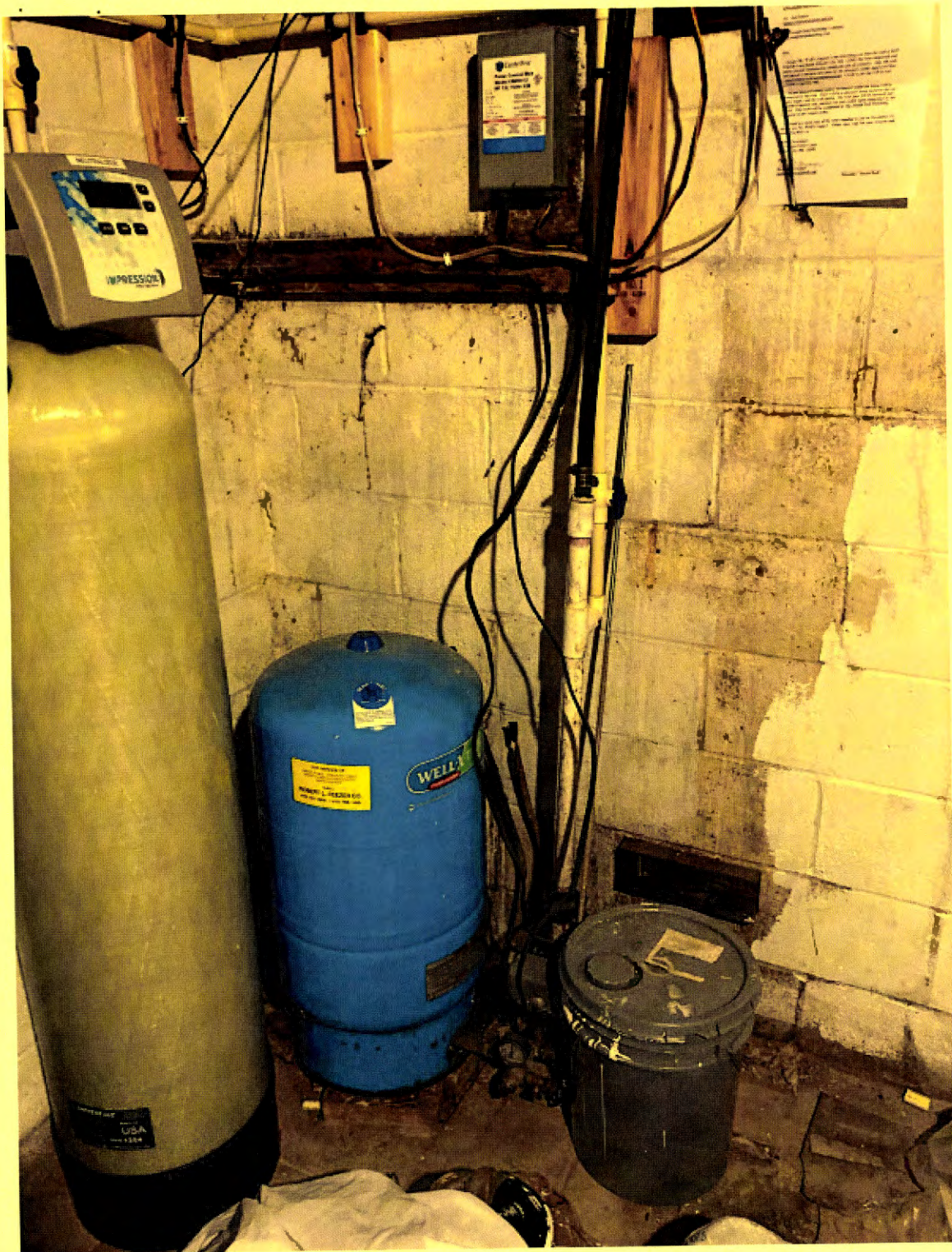

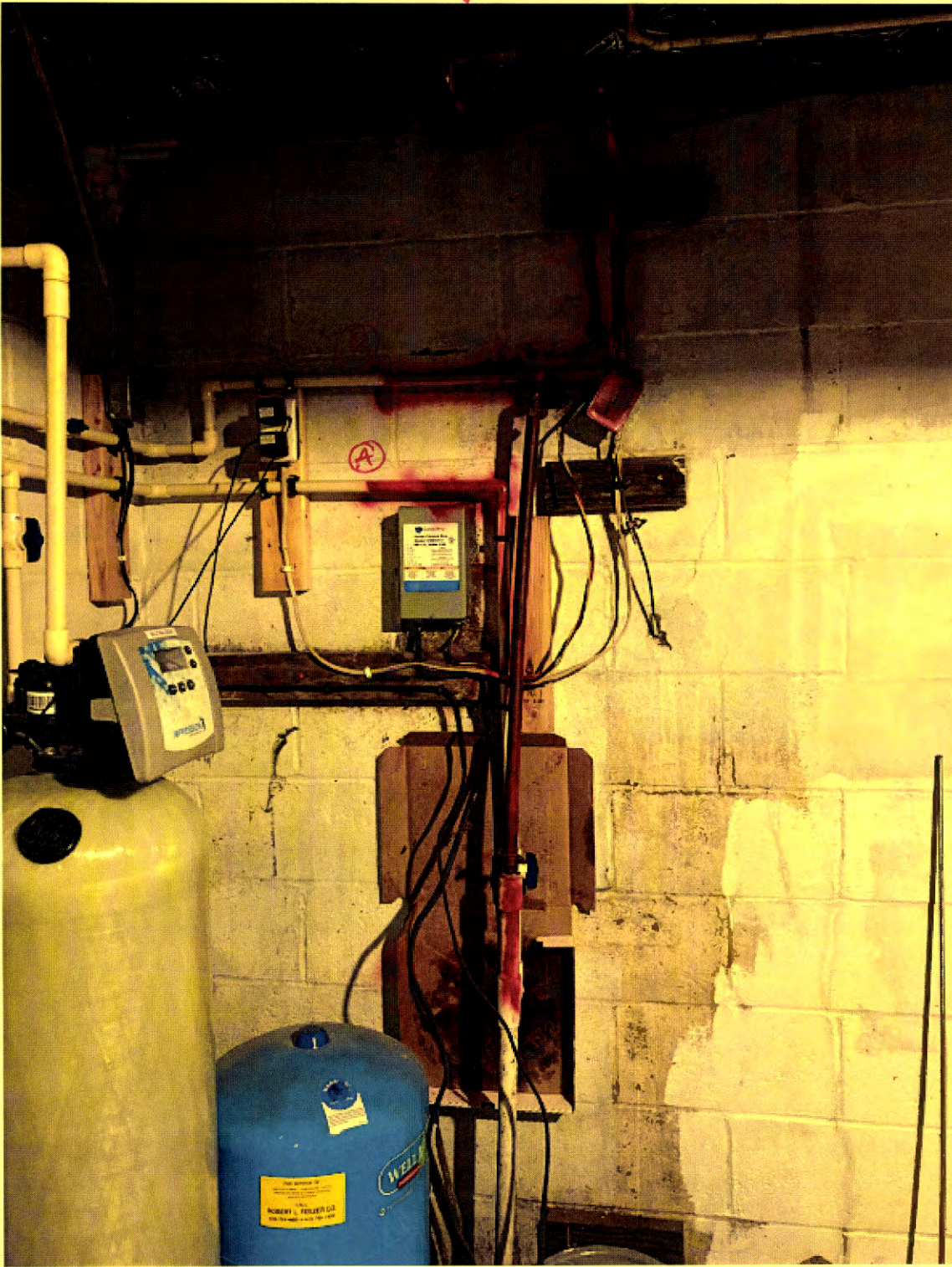

As per Mr. Wolf's request, I am informing you that the well at 8219 Church Lane Road, Ellicott City, Md. 21043, has been inspected and meets current construction standards and all setbacks. Also, the well has passed a bacteria test done by the Howard county approved firm Jemoseman@wellwatersolutions.net. I wish to use the well as non potable/irrigation only.

As per Howard county policy, no faucets inside the house will be connected to the well. There will be a physical break between the city water supply and the well piping. The well lines will be marked non potable/irrigation only, painted red and visible upon inspection by the county. This work will be completed by the Joseph Heil Plumbing Company as per county policy.
